AmeriCorps Members Needed Age restricted to 18-25 years old

Positions available as an AmeriCorps member with the Cayuga County Soil and Water Conservation District. We are looking to fill 6 positions before June 30th, 2010. You must be able to commit to 300 hours (about 8 weeks) of service.

YOU WILL RECEIVE:

1. **A FULL-TIME POSITION. 7am-3:30pm.** Learn hands-on conservation field experience while serving the community and protecting the environment. Typical job duties include but are not limited to: tree planting, seeding conservation areas, construction techniques, environmental practices, recycling events, environmental education programming, and much more.
2. **A Living Allowance** of at least \$300 per week (\$7.50/hr).
3. **AN Education Award** of \$1,000 that can be put toward higher education, vocational school, or student loan repayment.
4. **T-shirts with AmeriCorps logo.**

This is an excellent opportunity for individuals that are pursuing careers in the environmental field to work with technicians to get practical, hands-on field experience, while at the same time earning an education award to repay student loans or help pay for graduate school.
